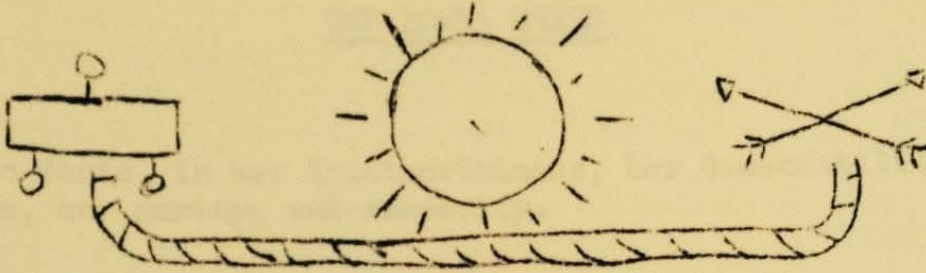


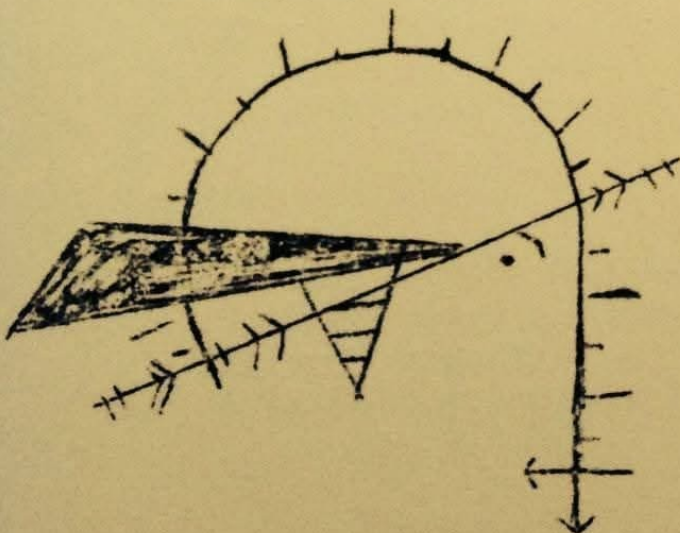
MEANING OF PLEDGE EMBLEM

- The Crossed Arrows represent friendship. The ones appearing in the pledge emblem represent friendship among girls; both among pledges themselves and between pledges and members.
- The Lasso represents pledging, or a Period of Captivity.
- The Bar and Bells represent duties and obligations. Along with the captivity of pledging come moments of uncertainty when duties and obligations weigh heavily on pledges.
- The Center Sun represents Moments of Happiness. By far, the most cherished memories are these moments of happiness.
- The Skyband represents Continued Happiness. Happiness of pledging leads in to the fuller happiness of membership.



MEANING OF MEMBERSHIP EMBLEM

- The Crossed Arrows represent friendship. These appear the same as in the pledge emblem and symbolize our continued and everlasting bond of friendship.
- The Sun's Rays represent Constancy. This surrounding symbol characterizes the Zonta member.
- The Bird represents the Calendar of the Club, the Festive Pow-Wows, and Sincere Service.
- The Teepee represents our temporary home at Phillips University.
- The Morning Star represents the Guidance we receive from Adult Sponsors and the Eternal Great Spirit.
- The Thunderbird Tracks represent Bright Prospects of Things to Come, Continual Friendships, Worthwhile Service, and Abundant Accomplishments of Zontas.
